MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT MARCH/APRIL, 2019

Annual Meeting-Mark your calendar!!!! It is that time of year again! Spring will soon be in the air hopefully! If you have never attended one of our annual meetings before, please try and make an effort to attend this year's meeting scheduled for Saturday, March 16th at 11 am at the Clubhouse. Meetings the last few years have been around an hour. We need a quorum (10%) of the total membership in good standing, which is currently about 50 members, to conduct Club business. And to be clear, if two members of the same household show up it only counts as one Club member for quorum purposes. The annual meeting is an opportunity for our Board of Governors and its committees to report to the membership all the activities of the Club. We will be presenting updates on our dam improvement (no update!) and the status of our clubhouse renovations. The annual meeting packet is posted on our webpage under members only. We will have light refreshments after the meeting. Come out of hibernation and meet a few of your neighbors!

Unfortunately, we were not able to get our Winter Carnival in again this year. Just when we had good ice, the temperature would warm up leaving the ice closest to the shoreline thin and unsafe for a crowd.

Our Swim Team committee begins its' monthly meetings to get ready for the season, so if you have a potential swimmer please try and attend. Our Social Committee is getting ready for all our spring and summer events and can always use new volunteers.

Our Budget committee met, and the Board approved our 2019/20 budget at our February meeting. Invoices for Club dues will be going out shortly. Our Board works hard all year long to control our costs and to be fiscally conservative plus nothing gets by our treasurer Marc Sanderson! Please remember that it is important for ALL members, not just a few, to donate some of their time to the Club from time to time, especially at our Work Days and with our committees to help control those costs. Without volunteerism, our dues would be significantly higher if we had to pay for all the labor to complete many of the projects and events throughout the year.

Our annual Work Day is scheduled for April 27th. As always, we need volunteers to help get the Club properties ready for the season. Please consider coming out for an hour or two to help. We have a light breakfast at 8 am and head out to the properties after that. If you are not sure where to go or what you can do, just stop at the Clubhouse first. We are generally done by 12 noon and have lunch available. There will be a Signup Genius put out the beginning of April.

Finally, it is that time of year; we will start to see more activity around the lake such as walkers/runners and bikers. Just a reminder to be alert and to please obey the posted speed limits throughout the lake to help ensure the safety of all our residents.



Summary of the Lake Shawnee Club Board Meetings

January 4, 2019

It was reported that the Club has collected a few more initiation fees; 21 houses have sold to date although only 15 were budgeted for the year.

Ms. Troha presented the Social Committee report as the newly appointed Social Committee Liaison. She noted that she has made the transition with the new Social Committee Chairs, Kristen White and Ruth Kuhl, in time for the new year. They are hoping for ice for the Winter Carnival on January 13th; the no ice date is February 10th. December Light Fight winners were East Side – Gast Family and West Side – Ryan/Coughlin Family. Both families were given lit arrowheads, since the judges were unable to choose a side as the overall winner. The next Social Committee meeting is January 8th and the updated annual Social Calendar is available on the website and in the LSNews. Finally, she reported on two new activities including the TLC thanks to Ms. Adrienne Najjar-Keith and Ms. Kristine Wilsusen, and the new Lake Shawnee Scholarship Committee. There was a brief discussion on the Scholarship Committee and their planned Lake Shawnee Race, which is being organized by Ms. Troha and Ms. McConnon.

The lights on the Message Board have finally been replaced with new LED lights.

It was noted that there has been some overflowing at Beaver Cove due to all the rain. The wetlands at Beaver Cove fills up quickly and affects the area neighbors, so the Club needs to keep on top of it.

Mr. Wilsusen and Mr. Paul Castimore blew the leaves on that property; the job was unable to be completed on Fall Work Day due to the rain. He noted that the gutters and downspouts on the Clubhouse are clogged and frozen; they will need to be cleaned in the spring.

It was noted that a small/child picnic table that was not chained was placed on the ice. After the ice melted, it floated back to shore and was retrieved; it is now chained.

Mr. Pichieri noted that he has received several complaints regarding storage for row boats at White's Cove. He will make signs to help alleviate the issue.

February 1, 2019

Under Social Committee, it was reported that Yoga is going well, Feb 11th is the rescheduled date for the Ice Carnival, and a CPR class is planned in February.

It was noted that member Ms. Alicia Szwec will be assisting with the ad content in the LSNews as decided upon at the last Board meeting and on the website cleaning up pages, as well. She would like to add telephone contacts, a news and announcements page, and a section for real estate and a trading post on the website. She will then focus on the fishing and the swim team pages. She wants to make the website more user friendly and incorporate the webpage with the newsletter. The Board thanked Ms. Szwec for all her hard work.

It was noted that there are no big ice fishing contests being held. They are focusing on "in house" contests only during the winter.

It was reported that per Swim Team bylaws, an ad was placed in the current edition of the LSNews for Head Coach and Assistant Coach for the upcoming season. Applications are due Feb 15th. Next, it was reported that the Swim Team Board met recently and will hold their first Swim Team Parent meeting on Feb. 26th when they will vote on a new board. Finally, the Golf Outing is scheduled for Friday, June 28th.

It was noted that a new window was installed in the Clubhouse, the picnic tables have been chained up at White's Cove, a tree at 2nd Beach that was leaning has been removed. There was a brief discussion on the light pole at North End. A new pole is on the property but needs to be installed; then electricity and a light can be installed.

The Board discussed the Clubhouse renovation project including a consultation with an acoustical engineer. A final decision will be made prior to the Annual Meeting in order to present to the membership.


