#### Dear Club Members,

NJ Executive Order# 143, permits Public & Private beaches to be open at sunup on May 24th. The Board of Governors have decided to open our beaches with the following rules & restrictions in place to comply with the order:

- We are required to limit access to our facilities so members only at this time, no guests, please. Exception: Nonfamily member caregivers.
- Physical distancing of 6 feet whenever practical excluding household members, family members, caretakers, romantic partners.
- No contact sports are allowed.
- Face covering strongly encourage when social/physical distancing cannot be maintained but not required.
- No picnic tables can be occupied to discourage gatherings.
- No parties of any type at this time. No grills, tables, tents on the property.
- Beach toys should be limited, and parents should ensure they are not shared with others outside the family unit.
- No flotation devices allowed.
- Personal chairs are permitted but should not be shared outside the family unit.
- · Swim docks and raft are closed.
- Playgrounds are still closed.

We ask all members to please be personally responsible for themselves and, in particular, their children when it comes to social/physical distancing and to please adhere to the rules. Lifeguards will be on duty. Our lifeguards and beach security have been instructed they are not the social distancing police, please do not put them in that position.

If the Board finds that members are not in compliance and cannot adhere to the order and to the rules put forth, removal from club property and loss of club privileges may result. We do not want to be in a position to close the facilities to all members. Remember, this is a soft opening, hopefully, as the season moves forward, these restrictions will ease up.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation. Let's please make this work for the benefit of all.



#### **Summary of the Lake Shawnee Club Board Meeting**

May 1, 2020

The monthly meeting of the Board of Governors was held virtually due to the current health crisis and social distancing regulations that remain in effec.

Mr. Wilsusen reported that the Governor reopened State parks beginning tomorrow with a limit of 10 people in a group.

There was a discussion by the Board on the plans for reopening of beaches amid the current situation. It was determined to plan on opening Memorial Day with lifeguards, dependent on Governor's orders at that time.

Next, there was a discussion on distributing badges. It was noted that an updated email was sent to members and we will continue to keep them informed as things are determined.

Work continues to be completed on properties by members as organized through Sign Up Genius, although most of the work has been completed. Mulch and QP along with new trees have been delivered; they will be spread and planted shortly. Sand will be delivered and spread at  $1^{st}$  and  $3^{rd}$  Beaches.  $2^{nd}$  Beach will need more leaf bags, the gate needs repairs and mulch needs to spread on the access ramp. Work needs to be completed on  $3^{rd}$  Beach decking, the raft needs to be pushed out and a large log needs to be removed and cut up.

A gas line will be run to the new Clubhouse as part of Phase 3 of the gas installation in the Reservation. This should be started in the next few weeks to be completed prior to the winter.

It was noted that more members have paid their dues in April than ever before, led specifically by the Seniors.

The Social Committee reported on their list of quarantine activities including many birthday parades. She thanked everyone for their contributions and posts and asks the Board to keep the ideas coming. She noted that the committee continues to hold their monthly meeting via Zoom online, so they can be ready to go once things begin to return to normal.

Mrs. McConnon updated the Board on the new monthly format of the LSNews during the current COVID-19 pandemic. She expressed her gratitude to all involved with producing the newsletter and said she was especially pleased with the May edition; it was especially uplifting during these difficult times. She hopes to resume the normal (every other month) format in the fall.

It was noted that Solitude Lake Management has begun their surveying of the lake for the season and the lake looks great. They noticed some filamentous algae, but the treatments from last year are still working at keeping down weed growth. They will back in two weeks.

The Board was updated on the status of the Clubhouse renovation project. The following update was provided: inside upstairs framed and all insulation in, downstairs office framed, old furnace removed, glass trophy case removed, heat and AC in office and kitchen area being installed, siding almost complete, deck in done, railing needs to be installed, handicap ramp upper is done, cement walkway needs to be installed from parking lot and railing needs to be installed, new door into kitchen needs to be replaced due to rot, and a new stove purchased and needs to be installed. There was a brief discussion on the time-line for completion of the project, which was anticipated for Memorial Day but may be closer to July 1st. A Grand Opening party will be planned for the membership once the project is completed.

There was a brief discussion on the Boating Policy, specifically the removal of boats during a Presidential Election year (next year). The Board will discuss at a future date.

Mrs. McConnon updated the Board on the Lake Shawnee Superhero 3-6-9. The race had to be postponed to the Governor's Stay at Home Orders amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Plans are to reschedule the race once things have returned to normal. Due to our generous sponsors and other donations throughout the year, the committee is once again able to give out over \$2000 in scholarships to three deserving individuals as determined by Scholarship Committee judges. The winners will be announced on June 9th and will be published in the July edition of the LSNews

#### Lake Shawnee Club Boat Rules-Storage Policy

- 1. **Boats are defined as**; any vessel including but not limited to any row boat, patio/deck boat, sailboat, canoe, paddle boat, kayak, paddle board or other watercraft.
- 2. All boats utilized on the lake or stored on any Club property are required to obtain a Club issued boat decal. Boat decals are valid through April 1st following a Presidential election year. The decal shall be valid for a period that does not exceed 4 years.
  - a. All Boat decals shall be affixed outside the vessel closest to the bow on either the port or starboard side.
  - b. Boats & watercraft cannot exceed 25 feet in length and cannot be capable of exceeding 15 mph.
  - c. Motorized boats must be electric powered only.
  - d. Member Guests launching boats on the lake shall have a guest badge in possession and present upon request.
  - e. Any boat & trailer launched into the lake must be clean and free of weeds.

#### 3. Boats stored on Club Property:

- a. Any member wishing to store a boat on Club property shall complete a boat storage permit at the Club Office. Storage permits will be issued on a first come first serve basis; assigned by property stored and valid for the requested property only. Should a member wish to move their boat to another property they must first notify the Club Office.
- b. Boats stored on Club property are to be stored on designated boat racks and in designated areas only. No boats are to be stored on the ground and will result in removal from the property.
- c. Boat owners storing boats on Club property are responsible to remove any water from boats within 48 hours of any rain event.
- d. All boats are to be removed from Club property by November 1st of any Presidential election year and can be returned after April 1st once a new storage permit is completed.
- e. Sailboats may be moored not more than 25 feet off club property at White's Cove & Third Beach within designated areas.
- f. Excluding sailboats, no boats are to be stored or left in the water off Club property for more than 24 hours.
- g. At White's Cove only and with the permission of the Club, handicap members as determined through a State Handicap Parking Permit, may leave their boat in water and/or request a closer/lower storage rack location. Provision 3c still applies.

#### 4. Policy Compliance

- a. Failure to comply with any section of this policy can result in loss of Club privileges as determined by the Board.
- b. All boats utilized on the lake are required to comply with existing NJ State laws and regulations regarding boats & vessels.


