

Distribution of Badges and Boat Permits 2021

Hello Lake Shawnee, Happy Spring time on the lake!

That time of year, dues invoices have been mailed and are payable beginning April 1, 2021. It is always a good time of year to become familiar with Lake Shawnee Club's Current Standing Rules and By-Laws on our website www.lakeshawneeclub.org. Password: member

The club office is open to process dues beginning April 1st. Please mail or drop your payment to the office mailbox (by the Club office door). Please social distance while waiting and please wear a mask.

Please follow the guidelines below for badge pick up and boat permit completion.

Badge distribution will be during our regular office hours: Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Due to Covid-19, please follow these protocols for 2021 Badge Pick Up. Please social distance while waiting and please wear a mask. if you mail or drop off payment at the club office mail box:

- 1. Register on Sign Up Genius for a time a date to pick up your badges. Use this link: https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10C0C49A4AC29A4F8C34-badge
- 2. Come to the Clubhouse on the date you registered for. Your badges will be hanging outside the windows for pick up. If you are in need of a boat permit, you will complete it at this time. Please social distance while waiting and please wear a mask.

 We will e-mail you a date for pick up.
- 4. <u>Boat Permits/Decals for Club Properties</u>: You must <u>come</u> to the office to fill out a boat storage permit and receive a decal/sticker for your vessel. This will be completed outdoors, weather permitting. You will be issued a decal for a *specific property*, 2nd beach, 3rd beach, White's Cove North End, Beaver's Cove, or Handicap(must show State Handicap Parking Permit). *You will not be issued a specific spot on that property.* Please do not put a boat on club property unless you have filled out a current boat storage permit and been issued a current boat decal. Boat without current decals/stickers will be removed from club property.

If you are keeping your boat on **your personal property**, please indicate the number of boats on bottom of invoice and decal/stickers will be issued. No boat permit is required and your decals will be in your badge envelope.
